Sermon Title: Hebrews 3: The Son, Our Brother, His Children

Scripture Reading: Hebrews 2:1-18

- 1. He is the Son, the Heir and highest authority: vs 3 "Therefore" Hear Him. vs 1, 5/1:3
  - a. Christ the starting point
  - b. Earnest listening Lk 8:18 vs 2
  - c. Greater accountability
  - d. Qualities of the prophet/apostle vs 4/3:1/2 Cor 12:12
- 2. From Adam to Jesus whom we see: vs 6-9 F/S principle- "The Son" vs 4/Luke 3:38/Hosea 6:7

The tension between type and reality: But unto the Son -3:6/4:14/5:8/7:3

- 3. The Son incarnate came to die: vs 9a/vs 3 "for this cause came I"/John 12:27-28
  - a. Exaltation through suffering
  - b. Tasting death for all me (The Father gave him) John 12:30; 17
  - c. His brethren vs 10, 11, 12
  - d. Honored to call us his brother
- 4. I and the children whom thou hast given me: vs 10, 13/Isa 8:17-18
  - a. Testimony of his labors—Gen 1:26-27/Isa 53:10-11; 60:4-5/Gal 4:19
  - b. His seed
- 5. The Son, our brother the Mediator: vs 17-18/Heb 13:20

"The line divine of revelation leads to a mediator" son, fathers, prophets, etc.

- a. An eternal covenant
- b. The covenant of works
- c. The covenant of redemption/grace
