Sermon Title: LORD, Let Me Be a Blessing Scripture Reading: Psalm 67:1-7

1. Mercy is always the bases for God's favor: Vs 1a

Ps 119:41/Titus 3:5/Eph 2:4 "The front door into Gods blessings is mercy"

2. The *nature of the blessing* is the revelation of His glory: Vs 1b

Num 6:24-25 a. His face (Presence/favor) b. His blessing—Gen 32:30 c. His Son—2 Cor 4:4-6 Ps 80:3, 7, 17-19

3. Make me (us) a vessel for your glory: Vs 2a

More than an object of blessing a vehicle, means, resource "Christ in you the hope of glory: 2 Cor 4:7/2 Tim 2:20-21/Rom 9:22-24

4. That thy way may be known in the earth: Vs 2a/John 14:6

(Christ is the way)

"That all men might honor the Son......John 5:23

6. The true yield, harvest, fruit of God's work: Vs 7

Believing nations- Rev 5:9 "nations/kindreds/tribes/tongues" John 10:16
