Sermon Title: The Gospel To The Romans: Revelation/Rebellion/Release **Scripture Reading:** Romans 1:18-25

$1.\;\;1.$ What is it that necessitates the preaching of the gospel? vs 18-20

- a. The Revelation of God's Wrath: vs 18/Ezek 37:1-10/Josiah/2 Chron 34:19-21
- b. The Rebellious response of all men to it: vs 19/John 3:19/Rom 7:6/ Luke 4:42/John 1:5
- *c.* The Righteous Revelation of God that renders man inexcusable: vs 20/Rom 2:14-15/Jonah Chap 3 (40 Days) They knew. Ps 19:1-3

2. The impact of this rebellion is a 3-fold exchange: vs 23a, 25a, 26b

- a. <u>Change the glory</u>—(His true Nature): Gen 3:1-7
- b. <u>Change the truth</u>—(His Revelation): Ex 32:24
- c. <u>They changed the complimentary purpose</u>: Gen 1:26-27; 2:22-24/ 1 Cor 11:8-12

This is the consequence of a culture's rejection of God: Rom 2:1-3

3. The Judgment of God in them: vs 21d, e

- a. (They) became vain in their thinking—Their file corrupted: Ps 115:3-8/Isa 45:14-20 Unreasonable and insensible = unable to put it together/ Their speculations are faulty!
- *b.* <u>Their passions departed from the light of God</u>—Dark deeds rule. Eph 5:3-8

4. Tell the Truth about God: vs 21—"GIVE HIM GLORY"

And enjoy the benefits by giving thanks for His goodness in your life.

- a. God is great in His nature—One great glorious God: Isa 45:21-22
- b. God is good to all his creatures: Acts 14:15-17/Mt 5:45; 6:11
- c. God is Saving in His purposes: Acts 17:31/1 Tim 2:5/2 Pet 3:9
