Sermon Title: Draw Nigh or Draw Back — Part 2

Scripture Reading: Hebrews 10: 24-39

1. Let us Draw near to God:

vs 22

A course of life, that leads to our standing before God on that last day. (This will be affirmed by the model of faith in chapter 11.)

(True worship) John 4:25/New covenant promises – Heb 10:16-18/

Mt 11:28/1 Pet 2:4/Heb 13:12-16 – (Lifestyle/Worship)

2. Let us hold fast the profession of our faith:

vs 23/6:10-12

“A public lifestyle of hope” – the future glory promised in Christ, which compels and drives the believer to live in purity of life.

1 John 3:3/Eph 5:3-4/Col 3:5-10, 12-14/1 John 2:28/

1 Cor 6:16-7:1—Ye are the temple of the Living God!

3. Let us consider, provoke, assemble, exhort:

vs 24-25

(great, care)

Mk 15:47/John 20:6/Acts 7:56/Rev 11:11

(spur, stir, sharp poke)

Acts 17:16; 15:39

(love/good works - epistles) assemble

Mt 23:23/Mt 24:31/2Thess 2:1

(preach/teach)

Acts 2:42/1 Tim 4:13-16/Peter’s job—John 21:15-17

4. The grounds for corporate and personal encouragement:

vs 32-35

Suffering/2 Tim 3:10-15

The goal of the adversary is to cause a defection from the gospel by persecution and seduction. (Pilgrim’s vision)

“The flame of faith, nurtured by the Spirit of Grace”. Rom 5:1-5

**5. Sinning willfully is a matter of the heart against the gospel:
vs 26-30**

The apostate has neglected to watch his heart.—Heb 3:12-15

- a. The cold heart—Mt 24:12-14
- b. The hard heart—Heb 3:13-16
- c. The divided heart—James 1:5-8
- d. The proud heart—Ps 10:2/Job 13:16

2 errors committed:

Idolatry of false doctrine—vs 29a-d

Immorality of grieving the Spirit—vs 29:e-f/Deut 29:16-19
