# **Sermon Title:** He That Believeth Not Shall Be Damned **Scripture Reading:** Mark 16:9-16/Hebrews 10:26-31

## 1. Sinning willfully is a matter of the heart against the gospel: vs 26-30

The apostate has neglected to watch his heart. Heb 3:12-15

- a. The cold heart—Mt 24:12-14
- b. The hard heart—Heb 3:13-16
- c. The divided heart—James 1:5-8
- d. The proud heart—Ps 10:2/Job 13:16

## 2. What is it to trod underfoot the blood of the Son of God? vs 27

- a. To become an adversary—Phil 3:17-19; 3:2-3
- b. To undo and reject its doctrinal claims—Ps 2:3
- c. To view it as useless and worthless—Mt 5:13 Recap Heb 6:6/an open shame
- d. To call God a Liar-1 John 5:10-12

#### 3. The Offence against the Spirit?

Insult, disrespect, resistance against His work in the conscience, mind, and understanding: the revelation, illumination, the display of Christ—by the Spirit—2 Pet 2:20-22

4 examples—1 Cor 10:1-12/Jude 1:5-6/Mt 12:31-37

#### 4. The Warrant for perseverance:

Meaning "personally, actively employing every means of grace to make credible your testimony of faith. "Fulfilling the Pattern" Heb 11; 6:12-15

- a. Is the *real and unavoidable apostasy* you will see with your own eyes
- b. The reward of faith, given only to those <u>who endure</u> to the end Mt 24:13/ 2 Tim 4:7/Heb 10:36

### 5. We believe to the saving of the soul:

No mere past tense salvation.

Salvation is to be understood as having its full <u>realization at the end</u> of our faith:

- You have been saved—Eph 2:8-9
- ▶ You are being saved—1 Cor 1:18
- You will be saved—1 Pet 1:9
