Sermon Title: The Gospel To The Romans: "Boasting in His Glory"

Scripture Reading: Psalm 34:1-17/Rom 5:1-5

1. The Joy of Glory to come: Rom 5:2-3

The Boast/Exultation: Ps 34:1-9 (in) 44:8

- a. The return of Christ: 2 Thess 1:10
(The great and glorious Rescue)
- b. The resurrection of the dead in Christ: 1 Cor 15:42-44
(recovery of the purchased possession)
- c. The glorification of our bodies: 1 Cor 15:51-52/Phil 3:20

**2. Tribulation is the way: Rom 5:4/Mt 7:14/Acts 14:22/2 Tim 3:12/
John 16:33**

- a. Right with God means wrong with the world:
John 15:18-19/James 4:4
- b. Right with God means wrong with yourself:
Rom 7:23-25/Gal 5:17/James 4:4-5
- c. This conflict is designed to produce in us *a hope*:
1 Pet 1:3-7/Rom 8:24-25
- d. Look for the glory of God in it!
Dan 3:16-18, 25 (The Presence and liberty)

3. There is a supply of Grace, called the love of God, poured out. Why?

- a. Christ's love *for* us: John 17:24—**desired**
- b. Christ's love *in* us: 2 Cor 3:6-7—**contained**
- c. Christ's love *to* us: Acts 7:55-56—**fulfilled**

***Therefore, children of God, glory, exalt, and boast in God
for His justifying Grace!***
