1. The Typology of Adam to Christ: vs 14/Heb 8:5

- a. Tupos—print, mark, pattern, example, figure, image:
John 20:25/Rom 6:17/1 Cor 10:6, 11/Phil 3:17/1 Thess 1:7/1 Pet 5:3
- b. We are all called to be forged and shaped by the gospel—(His Image)

2. The Parallels

- a. Firstborn—(One Man): Rom 8:29
12 x (Spiritual Government)
- b. Representative: Judges 20:11/Ezra 3:1
- c. One Act was for all: 1 Sam 17:8-9/John 18:8/Heb 10:14; 2:10-11

3. The Glorious Contrast: vs 15, 18-19

- a. Not as—so also
- b. Cursed as a reward/The FREE grace gift of God’s Righteousness: Rom 6:23
- c. Adam 1—a mere man/The Last Adam—The God Man:
Phil 2:6-7/1 Cor 15:47
- d. Adam brought condemnation and death/
Christ brought justification and eternal life
- e. Adam was temporarily good/
Christ is everlastingly perfect
- f. Because of Him your righteousness is certain: Isa 54:17
