### I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE WHICH CAME DOWN FROM HEAVEN

#### Exodus 16:1-18/John 6:31-35

**1. Another test another revelation: vs 1-3 (4)**

- a. Murmuring exposing the horizontal dilemma  
"Failure to see or believe God"
- b. complaint – Moses/Aaron- (instrument vs source)
- c. The delusion of better days - Eccl 7:10
- d. Contradicts a forward moving agenda - Heb 11: 15,16

**2. An act of redemptive Revelation: vs 4a/vs 13-15**

Bread/instead of judgment/Covenant emblems revealed/promise to Abraham/Gen 15: 13-14/with whom in view? Gal 3:16-19

**3. Accommodating our weakness: vs 12 - 13/3 vs Ps 103:13-14**

It's his nature to care /He understands who we are. This is not the same as affirming our sin. Ex 34:7/God is Faithful – He can be trusted. Phil 1:6

**4. The obedience of Faith, again: vs 4b/16-18 to prove –15:25- God has chosen to test our faith. This**

is the economy of our relationship with him.  
Ps 105:19 – 1 Thess 2:4 (Abram Gen 22 /Joseph/Job/David)

**5. The simplicity of Christ The glory of God: vs 14-15/6-7- 16:31**

The glory of God- Purity/Plainness/ Humility of the mediator – coming down- condescending,  
Phil 2:5-7 - A stumbling block to the proud. 2 Cor 11:1-3

**6. The sufficiency of the Gospel as Our daily portion. vs 16-18:**

- a. Each man an homer
- b. The waste of excess: vs19
- c. The lack of equality
- d. The dishonor of grace and its power to sustain you all the way through.  
2 Cor 8:14,15 - Mt 6:9-13

**7. The Glory of God in Christ that leads to rest: vs 22-26/Mt 11:28**

- a. The gospel leads to rest. (True Worship) Is 32:17
- b. When there is no rest, you have abandoned the gospels authority
- c. A return to the gospel is a return to rest.
- d. The rest of the soul is evidence of the power and presence of the gospel.
- e. Neglect or abuse, or diminishing of the gospel will result in an absence of rest before God.
- f. Contentment with Christ is great gain.
