Sermon Title: The Church at Thyatira: The Blessing and Danger of Good Works

Scripture Reading: Rev 2:18-24

1. The virtues of good works: vs 19

- a. The *practical* evidence of faith: James 2:15-20
- b. The **work of** God: Eph 2:10/John 15:1, 4, 8
 Truly good works
- c. It *adorns* the gospel: Titus 2:10 Nice meal on a filthy plate
- d. It will <u>justify you</u> and God on the last day: 1 Pet 2:11-12

2. The <u>danger of</u> good works: vs 19 (17)

"They increased more and more"

- Feeding the poor, but not preaching to their souls.
 Mt 23:23/Mk 8:36
- b. Fighting social ills without it being a premise for the truth. "A Trojan horse"
- c. Ecumenical involvement leading to an assumption of Christian unity. Luke 11:25

3. The *compromise of* truth, a foreshadow of our present liberal Churches:

vs 20

- a. An *abandonment of biblical* authority 2 Tim 4:2-4/1 Tim 2:9/1 Cor 14:24-25
- b. The influence of charismatic feminism: Amy McPherson/Ellen G/Paula White, etc.
- c. A rejection of Apostolic authority:"She calls herself a prophetess"—P/R1 Cor 15:36-37
- d. Tolerance (cowardliness) has allowed her to produce an offspring: vs 23

4. It starts in the dark, but the Son of God sees it: vs 18c

- a. They creep in first: Jude 4
- b. They disseminate gradually: 2 Tim 2:17/Gal 5:9
- c. They practice private worship: Ez 8:3-25
- 5. Balaam and Jezebel—Old Testament types of present day error: (To be developed)
