Sermon Title: How Do You See THINGS: According to Man or God? APPREHENDING CHRIST According to THE GOSPEL Scripture Reading: Numbers 13:17-33

- 1. The application to us is justified: Rom 15:4/Heb 4:2/Eccl 1:9
 - a. We've met God
 - b. Wandering in the wilderness
 - c. Waiting on the promise
 - d. History is a sure gage, guide, and mirror to the present and the future
- 2. Tasting the evidence of His promises in the present: 20, 23, 24 (Eschol) "We taste now" God has always invited us to *experience* His grace. Ps 34:8/Prov 24:13/1 Pet 2:3/Heb 6:4-5

- 3. 5 of 7 lessons to be learned in this tragedy
 - a. The taste is a proof of His faithfulness to us: vs 21-25
 - b. They correspond to the grace of God presently operating in our life: Phil 4:19 a constant supply of Grace Mk 16:17-20/1 Cor 1:9/Phil 1:6
 - c. Properly evaluating this journey of faith: vs 26-29 Luke 14:27/John 16:33/Mt 10:16/Mk 9:35-38
 - d. A knowledge of the warfare is essential to the truth, but it *doesn't produce* faith: Eph 6:11/1 Cor 2:11/1 Peter 5:8/
 1 Cor 14:20/Phil 4:8; 1:27
 - e. Faith is a gift of God: Eph 2:5-8/1 Pet (Elect) 1:1-2/ 2 Cor 4:6/13 "The Non-elect"

(Babe/Mature) 2 Visions – two different emphasis/ Num 13:30
