THE GOSPEL TO THE ROMANS "Called, Justified, and Glorified—#2"

1 Cor 1:18-31/Rom 8:29-30

- 1. Called effectually and powerfully to the saving of the soul: Jn 10:24-28/1 Thess 2:13
 - a. Called by the gospel: 1 Cor 1:18-24/2 Tim 1:8
 - b. Called to be saints: Rom 8:28; 1:6-7/1 Cor 1:2/Jude 1:1/Rev17:4
 - c. Called to suffering and glory: Phil 1:29/2 Pet 1:4-5 (His own glory)
- 2. Justification is a 4-fold reality revealed in the scriptures: Rom 8:30
 - a. We were justified in the eternal purposes of God: Rev 13:8/Hab 2:4/Rom 1:16-17
 - b. We were justified in time by the cross of Christ: 1 Pet 3:18/Isa 53:11
 - c. We are justified by faith in our own conscience when the Spirit works: Rom 4:24-25/1 Cor 6:11/Jn 16:8
 - d. We will be justified by God for believing the gospel on the last day: Rom 2:13/Mt 12:37/Rom14:12
- 3. Glorification is the grand finale of God's eternal redemptive goal: Rom 3:23
 - a. The glory of God revealed in Christ: John 1:14/2 Pet 1:17
 - b. The Spirit of glory in us: 1 Pet 4:14/John 17:22/Acts 6:15
 - c. The consummate glory at His return: Rom 8:17, 21/2 Thess 1:10/Rev 21:1
