## Sermon Title: THE GOSPEL OF YOUR SALVATION — PART 4 THE SUCCESSFUL ATONEMENT OF CHRIST FOR HIS ELECT — PT. 1

## Scripture Reading: Romans 5:1-11

The Four questions of Salvation: WHO? WHEN? HOW? WHY?

1. The Gospel of atonement for sin is unlimited in its offer not its application:

John 1:29-3:16/Rom 10:11-13

- a. All nations—Mt 24:14
- b. Category—Gal 3:28
- c. Not every single individual
- d. "Not all have or will hear"—Acts 2:39

To reconcile, unite, bring together in harmony, **AT – ONE – MENT**, by cover/remove

## 2. The objects of the atonement are particular. Mt 1:21/Jn 10:15/Eph 5:25-26

A universal atonement has never been the statement of scripture. Israel vs Lev 16:34

Specific to a person—Lev 1:4/Or the family—Ex 12:13

- 3. The atonement at no point was or is a failure: Mt 1:21/Jn 11:49-52/1 Jn2:2/Jn 6:37-39; 10:15-18/2 Cor 5:18
- 4. What did Christ do to atone for our sins? 4 things
  - a. He died as a lamb, to satisfy His Fathers Justice, against my transgression and sin against Him. Isa
    53:11/satisfaction/payment: Debtor to justice
    Rom 3:23-25
  - b. **Removed the legal guilt of my criminal life** that held me and God in hostility, enmity, separation, at war. Isa 59:2-3/I was a fugitive of Justice, running from God. Rom 8:6-7—<u>Adam and Eve, in the garden, hiding from God</u>.

That is what sinners do when they are not saved, when they have not been reconciled to God, they run, hide, fight, argue...

c. He <u>reconciled us</u> to GOD: Col 1:21/He did it <u>by his</u> death—Col 1:22/Lev 17:11

"He clothed them" 2 Cor 5:18

- d. He did it as a real substitute, taking our place, standing in our room, bearing God's wrath—Isa 53:4/1 Pt 3:18/Num 25:13 HOW? 1 Cor 15:1-4
- e. **He did it to actually set me free**—John 18:4-9—Let these go! Whom? All that the Father had given him.
