

## Outline - Sunday, August 31, 2014

Sermon Title: The Church at Sardis: True Believers Never Blotted Out Scripture Reading: Ex 32:19-35/Rev 3:6-7

## 1. This ominous analogy of expulsion from citizenship in the kingdom of God:

- a. Its thoroughly biblical and referenced several times: Ps 56:8; 87:6; 139:16; Luke 10:20
- b. Apostates are removed: Ps 69:28; 109:13/Ezek 13:9
- c. It is wholly consistent with both the character of an holy God who will not have sin in his presence: Mt 13:41-42—"cast out" language—Mt 22:11-14
- d. Sin will blot you out of His book all sin: Ex 32:33/Rom 6:23
- e. The great sin in view is abandonment of the gospel: Ex 33:23-25/Rev 21:8, 27
- f. Christ is the only remedy for this and every other sin: Heb 1:3; 9:15/1 John 3:3

## 2. The Recognition of those who Remain: vs 4

- a. A few undefiled garments: Jude 1:20-23/James 1:19
- b. The believer's witness: Job 12:5
- c. The method of garment cleansing: Rev 7:14/1 John 1:9/2 Cor 7:1
- d. The motive for clean garments? Eph 5:25-27/Rev 19:7/1 John 3:3

## 3. The Reward of Grace Promised: vs 5-6 "Overcomers"

- a. Will be Clothed in white raiment "future tense" F.I.M.
  *Promised*—2 Cor 5:21
  *Given*—Rev 6:11
  *Displayed*—Rev 19:8
  *The Walk*
- A permanent name in glory: book of life leger of citizenship: Phil 3:20/Rev 13:8; 17:8/Dan 12:1
- c. Not blotted out [The ultimate loss]: Ex 32:32-33
- d. Christ died for the sins of His people "He was blotted out" The ultimate curse: Isa 53:8
- e. My name is permanently inscribed in the book by His blood (Lamb's book): Rev 20:12
