Sermon Title: THE GOSPEL OF YOUR SALVATION — PART 5

"He hath Turned Away My Wrath"—Phineas a type of Christ our Mediator 1

Scripture Reading: Numbers 25:1-18

1. The Last temptation before crossing Jordan: Num 33:49 (42) Encampments

- a. Seduction—Rev 17 great Whore
- b. Idolatry—2 Thes 2:9-12
- 2. 3 Judgments: vs 3
 - a. God's plague on the people—vs 9

(covenant curse) Lev 26/Deut 28-31/1 Cor 10:8

- b. Capitol punishment on corrupt leadership—vs 5 (Deut 21:23)
- c. The death of two religious fornicators—vs Heb 13:4
- 3. The Mediatorial work of Phineas atoned for the sin: vs 6-7
 - a. The source of sin identified—Baal peor/spiritual fornication—Rev 2
 - b. The zeal for God's glory executed—Isa 59:16
 - c. The wrath of God satisfied—Isa 53:10-12/None/for Levi's house—1 Sam 3:4
 - d. Phineas a great type of Christ—atones/is rewarded with a perpetual priesthood

"All because of Zeal—He whipped—Jn 2:17/Wept—Luke 19:41/Whipped/And died!

Proposition:

4. Atonement for sin actually satisfies the Justice of God: vs 10 lt actually turns God's just and Holy anger away.

Implications considered—Toplady—John Owens

- a. The triumph of the atonement in his name: Character of God

 Ex 34:5-7/the offense committed/the atonement as the solution/the transfer of the sins—to HIM!
- b. The triumph of the atonement in His work of justification: 2 Cor 5:20-21
 The offense of sins against God placed upon Christ, are now satisfactorily punished, atoned, propitiated, put away. 1 Pet 3:18—We are coming to God!
- c. **The triumph of the atonement** <u>for the covenant</u>: This is a salvation based upon covenant. Between a covenant God and a covenant people.

Lev 16: 5-8/Heb 10:16-18 (Father) Heb 9:22/Lk 22:20 (Son) Ezek 36:27/ (Spirit) John 10:15-17

- d. **The triumph of the atonement in** <u>the soul:</u> The Spirit must save;
 - The inheritance applied. Salvation it self, regeneration itself is an evidence of the triumph of the atonement. John 12:31/Rom 5:9/Job 33:15-30
- e. **The triumph of the atonement** *for the gospel*: The efficacy of the proclamation of Christ is because of the atonement accomplished. Mt 28:18-19/Rom 10:17/1 Cor 15:1-4
